Subject: Difficult to adjust cabin temperature comfortable/It is always warmer than setting on Temp. Control Dial

DESCRIPTION

Some customers may complain that it is difficult to adjust the cabin temperature comfortable using the auto air conditioner. The number of customer complaint increases when the outside temperature is around 10°C.

[Customer comment samples]

- The cabin temperature does not decrease to the customer desire (i.e. the set temperature on the temperature control dial). It is warmer in the vehicle cabin than the selected temperature.
- Even if adjusting the set temperature on the temperature control dial to decrease the cabin temperature, the air conditioner always blow out too warm air from the vents.
- When the outside temperature becomes around 10°C at the change of seasons, the customer first set the temperature control dial to 22°C to warm up the cabin. After the cabin temperature increases and the customer feels it is too warm, the customer decreases the set temperature but the blow-out air temperature does not change that much as expected and remains too warm. If it is adjusted to "Max. Cold" then too much cold air blows out and it is difficult to adjust the cabin temperature comfortable.

CAUSE

The control logic of the climate control unit is not appropriate when the outside temperature is in the specified range.

MASS PRODUCTION CHANGE

The control logic in the climate control unit has been changed to adjust the blow-out air temperatures appropriate.


